Child-Centered Play Therapy (CCPT) is a form of play therapy that facilitates a child ' s experience of self-direction, integration, and growth (Bratton, Ray, & Landreth, 2008). In particular, CCPT provides children an opportunity to express positive and negative emotions using toys and different materials of their choice as an indirect way of exploring specific events, beliefs, and feelings.
